

The Rufous-sided Towhee*

Three songs for alto recorder

These songs should be played with slurs, not 'recorder legato', either as written or *ad lib*. If your recorder does not handle slurs over register breaks well, please feel free to omit them there. *The Rufous-sided Towhee* has nothing to do with the bird, other than the fact that a towhee was present when the song was written. The piece should combine a 'celtic' simplicity with the Telemann-like figures. *Shades of Green* is a simple tune, originally written as a prelude to a suite with percussion. *Blue Shadows* needs rhythmic definition throughout.
